

Environmental Resources Technician

Ulster County Department of the Environment is seeking qualified applicants to fill our **Environmental Resources Technician** position. The UC Department of the Environment is responsible for coordinating environmental efforts and initiatives across county government operations. The Department's areas of responsibility are diverse and include water resources, environmental planning, sustainability, and building energy management. Our Department has received numerous state and national environmental awards/recognitions for our work. Our GIS based habitat mapping project was featured in the December 2016 edition of National Geographic.

For the position of Environmental Resource Technician, we are looking for candidates with a demonstrated interest and strength in water resources and/or watershed management. Among other related job duties, the successful applicant for this position would be responsible for coordinating the County's stormwater program. The successful candidate will have: good knowledge of the principles, practices, purposes and techniques used in environmental and natural resources planning and conservation management; working knowledge of the methods and techniques of collection and interpretation of data; ability to prepare and generate reports; ability to create GIS maps; ability to collect field data using GPS units; and the ability to present ideas clearly and effectively both orally and in writing.

Minimum qualifications include either: a Bachelor's Degree in Environmental Studies, Natural Resources Management, Natural Science or a related field; **OR** an Associate's Degree in Environmental Studies, Natural Resources Management, Natural Science or related field and two years of full-time paid, or its' part-time equivalent, experience in environmental resource research and identification, environmental planning, or similar experience; **OR** an equivalent combination of training and experience as indicated in A and B.

This is a full-time, benefitted position. Salary starts at \$25.08/hr.
