**ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES:** Eligible candidates include graduate and undergraduate students pursuing a career in Geography, GIS, infrastructure management, Planning, or a related field. Candidates should have a demonstrated working knowledge, experience, and or coursework with any of the following: ESRI Arc GIS software, ESRI Arc GIS Online / Enterprise platforms, basic ESRI Arc GIS Application Design, GPS, database creation and design, and or cartographic design. An understanding of municipal infrastructure and/or ESRI's Geometric Network database format is highly desirable. Candidates are expected to have strong communication and organizational skills, and an ability to work as part of a team or independently when needed. Attention to detail and quality of work, and a demonstrated work ethic are highly desirable traits. Eligible candidates are required to participate in in-person interviews.
